About the KRU Dr.MR Appa Row College of PG studies:

The Post Graduate Centre at Nuzvid (Mango town) was started by Andhra University with the personal efforts of the then Vice-Chancellor of Andhra University Late Prof.M.R.Appa Row, with three Post Graduate Courses viz., M.Sc., Applied Mathematics, M.Sc. 


