**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON ACADEMIC EXCHANGE**

**BETWEEN**

**KRISHNA UNIVERSITY, MACHILIPATNAM, INDIA  
AND  
CHANG JUNG CHRISTIAN UNIVERSITY, TINAN, TAIWAN**

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter called "MOU") on Academic/Research Exchange between Krishna University (hereinafter referred to as "KRU" or "Party" or "University") and Chang Jung Christian University (hereinafter referred to as "CJCU" or "Party" or "University"), collectively referred to hereinafter as the "Parties" or "Universities".

**WHEREAS:**

1. The Parties agree to enter into an agreement for academic exchange;
2. The Parties recognize that the academic exchanges will promote further educational collaboration and cultural understanding and have agree to further continue their common interest in promoting the mutual cooperation in the area of education and research; and
3. The parties to implement the MOU under the terms and condition hereinafter set forth.

**HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:**

**ARTICLE I  
PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE**

1. The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to make possible and to facilitate the exchange of students, scholars and educational resources between KRU and CJCU, based upon principles of mutual and the reciprocity of benefits;
2. The objective of this MOU is to strengthen ties between both Parties and to promote academic cooperation and to further the understanding of the culture of the two countries concerned.

**ARTICLE II  
SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES**

The scope of activities of the MOU shall include:

**A. ACADEMIC STAFF PROGRAM**

1. Visits by academic staff will be encouraged for the mutual benefit of both Parties. Each Party will accept scholars from the other Party. Suitable arrangements will be made for the exchange of visiting scholars for collaboration in teaching and in research in case by case basis;
2. The host university will provide the normal services for visiting scholars including access to laboratory facilities;
3. The host university will assist, as far as possible, in arranging accommodation for the visiting scholar, and will assist the visiting scholar in matters of immigration, stay and working permit, health, language and local custom.

**B. JOINT RESEARCH PROGRAM**

1. The Parties will seek opportunities to cooperate in research. The details of specific research proposals will be determined by the mutual agreement of relevant faculties of both universities;
2. The form of cooperation may vary with the goal of each project. Details concerning Intellectual Property are addressed in Article IV;
3. Otherwise the parties agree that, in the event of research collaboration leading to patent rights, copyrights and other intellectual property rights that require a further agreement on special intellectual property, a concerned agreement must be entered into each case in accordance with the policies of the KRU and CJCU on intellectual property.

**C. CULTURAL EXCHANGE PROGRAM**

1. To facilitate academic and cultural interchange, the exchange of research materials, publications and information will be encourage;

2. Each university will invite the other, when appropriate, to participate in conferences, symposia and short visits. Joint educational programmes and joint curriculum development are encouraged as well.

#### **D. STUDENT PROGRAM**

The student exchange program is detailed in an attached Plan of Operation. Other activities under the student program may include joint supervision of postgraduate students, and the provision of library access and academic assistance for doctoral research students. Such activities shall be negotiated and agreed to by Parties on a case-by-case basis.

#### **E. OTHER ACADEMIC EXCHANGE TO WHICH BOTH UNIVERSITIES AGREE.**

### **ARTICLE III FORMS OF COOPERATION**

Academic and Research cooperation shall take the following forms:

1. Participating in conferences, seminars, workshops, and symposia organized by either of the Parties, and exchanging students, faculty and researchers and faculty members, and
2. Exchanging academic and scientific information in fields of mutual interest;
3. Implementing cooperative academic and research programs;
4. Arranging opportunities to make facilities and equipment of one party available to researchers from the other party;
5. Encouraging direct contacts between researchers and faculty members;
6. Meetings between representatives of the Parties as required to review the progress of research cooperation every year and to discuss future cooperation plans.

### **ARTICLE IV OFFICIAL LANGUAGE**

All letters, drawings, reports and other documents executed for the implementation of the MOU and all bilateral discussions conducted between the Parties shall be in English.

**ARTICLE V**  
**CONTRIBUTION BY KRISHNA UNIVERISTY AND NATIONAL CENTRAL UNIVERSITY**

In accordance with the prevailing laws and regulations in India and Taiwan, and subject to personnel limitations, KRU and CJCUC shall:

1. See finance of joint activities from sources available to them;
2. Provide necessary funding to assist in the implementation of activities;
3. Assign qualified experts and lecturers to assist in the implementation of activities under this MOU.

**ARTICLE VI**  
**INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY (IP) RIGHTS, RESULTS AND PUBLICATIONS**

1. Each of KRU and CJCUC hereby licenses the other to use its background Intellectual Property (Background IP) for the purposes of activities contemplated by the MOU. Any Intellectual Property developed as a result contemplated by the MOU (Developed IP) shall be jointly owned as tenants in common equal shares;
2. Each of KRU and CJCUC shall have the right to freely use Developed IP and Background IP of the other party for their own non-commercial, educational, scholastic and research endeavors including rights of publication. As a matter of courtesy, each of UI and CJCUC will forward English language copies of relevant articles or conference papers, written or delivered, which contain Background IP or Developed IP;
3. Neither party shall commercialize nor attempt to commercialize any Developed IP resulted from the cooperation activities under this MOU without the consent of the other party. Any commercialization shall not affect the license rights in 1 and 2 above;
4. If either party wishes to disclose confidential data and/or information resulted from the cooperation activities under this MOU to any third party, the disclosing party must obtain prior consent from the other party before any disclosure can be made. Consent is not to be unreasonably withheld;

5. Whenever either party requires the cooperation of another party outside India and Taiwan for any commercial undertaking resulting from the Intellectual Property covered by this MOU, this party will give preference of cooperation to the other party under this MOU, which will be waived if the other party is unable to participate in mutually beneficial manner;
6. Termination of this MOU shall not affect rights/obligations under this article during the first twenty (20) years after termination.

**ARTICLE VII**  
**AMENDMENTS, EFFECTIVE DATE, DURATION AND TERMINATION**

1. This MOU can be amended by mutual consent of the two parties. Any amendments to this MOU can only be made in writing and after consultation and mutual consent of the parties. Such amendments, once approved by the Parties, will become part of this MOU;
2. The effective date this MOU shall be the latter date on which the Parties sign this MOU;
3. This MOU shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature. The MOU may be extended by mutual consent of the two parties
4. The MOU may be terminated by either party by giving written notice at least six months in advance to the other Party. The event of termination will not affect participants from completing their activities at the host institutions.
5. In case the MOU ceases to be effective on account of termination or expiration, the provisions of all valid Plan of Operation documents shall continue to apply to the extent necessary to secure the implementation of existing activities as agreed upon in the Plan of Operation documents.

3. This MOU shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature. The MOU may be extended by mutual consent of the two parties
4. The MOU may be terminated by either party by giving written notice at least six months in advance to the other Party. The event of termination will not affect participants from completing their activities at the host institutions.
5. In case the MOU ceases to be effective on account of termination or expiration, the provisions of all valid Plan of Operation documents shall continue to apply to the extent necessary to secure the implementation of existing activities as agreed upon in the Plan of Operation documents.



IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have caused this MOU to be executed by their duly authorized representatives.


